**EXPENDITURE FOR SKILL TRAINING**

**1431. SHRI SANJAY SINGH:**

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of persons provided with skill development certification under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) till date since the inception of the scheme;
- (b) out of the total skill certified under the scheme, the number of persons that got jobs, so far;
- (c) the average expenditure per person being made by Government during the process of making one skilled under the scheme and getting the job;
- (d) the average income of persons getting the job, after being skill certified under the scheme; and
- (e) the details thereof, State-wise and gender-wise?

**ANSWER**

**MINISTER OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP  
(SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)**

(a) Skill India Mission aims to empower the Indian youth through skill development. Under the Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing its flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) to impart skill development training to youth across the country. PMKVY has two components, namely Short Term Training (STT), and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Since inception, 104.49 lakh candidates (52.46 lakh in STT and 52.03 lakh in RPL) have been certified under PMKVY.

(b) STT is linked to placement, while RPL recognizes the existing skills of candidate and does not mandate placement. Under STT-PMKVY, as on 10.07.2021, 52.46 lakh candidates have been certified; out of which, 23.2 lakh candidates have been placed.

(c) The average per candidate cost for STT and RPL under PMKVY, as per approved guidelines, is given below:

\*Note: Average cost is excluding newly added provision/incentives under PMKVY 3.0 such as One time Placement Travel Cost to candidates, Career Progression support, Special Incentive for Foreign Placements, Additional Support to Divyang Candidates, English Employability and Entrepreneurship (EEE) module, Mobile Tracking Allowance, Payment to AEBAS, Training of Trainer Fee, Trainer of Assessor Fee etc.

(d) Under STT-PMKVY 2.0, the reported average salary of a candidate is around Rs. 8,500 per month.

(e) The State/UT-wise and gender-wise average salary of candidates getting placed under the placement linked STT-PMKVY, as on 10.07.2021, is given at *Annexure*.
