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STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) AND (b) of RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 100 FOR 27.11.2019 ASKED BY SHRI SANJAY SINGH REGARDING EXPLOITATION OF HOME GARMENT WORKERS.

(a) & (b): The State Governments are the appropriate Government for the purpose of enforcement of the labour laws applicable to home garment workers, sub-contractors engaging such workers and fashion brands. The State Government enforcement agencies implement various labour laws including the Code on Wages, 2019, the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition), Act, 1970, to regulate the employment and conditions of service of workers and protect them from exploitation. The Code on Wages, 2019, inter-alia, ensures payment of wages not less than the minimum rate of wages, timely payment of wages and equal remuneration to the workers to prevent discrimination between workers on grounds of gender.
