AFFORDABLE COVID-19 VACCINE FOR ALL

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government plans to distribute the COVID-19 vaccine free of cost to any section of the population in the country

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the number of intended beneficiaries and expected expenditure thereon and

(c) the steps taken by Government to make the vaccine affordable for the people Below Poverty Line and the Economically Weaker Sections of the society?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) and (b): During the first phase, the vaccine is being provided free of cost to States and UTs for vaccination of Health Care Workers and Front Line Workers. As on 4th February 2021, a total of 96.28 lakh Health Care Workers and 78.51 lakh Front Line Workers have been identified for COVID-19 vaccination. The data base of Front Line Workers is in the process of getting updated on the Co-Win digital platform. The expenditure to be incurred as operational cost for vaccination of estimated 3 crore Health Care Workers and Front Line Workers is about Rs. 480 crores and vaccines cost is about Rs. 1392.82 crores.

(c): Presently, the vaccine is being provided free of cost to Health Care Workers and Front Line Workers.
